

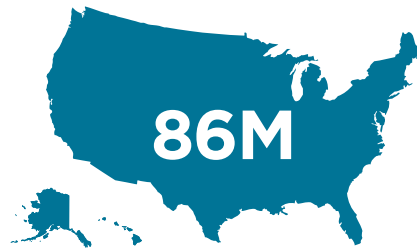
The Staggering Costs of Diabetes
