



The 100 Mile Century Challenge for the Cure

Challenge for the Cure* starts and finishes in picturesque Del Mar, CA and has an elevation of 4,042 feet. Ride through San Diego's finest communities as you venture up the coast along Highway 101 to Oceanside, CA. The route transitions from Highway 101 onto the San Luis Rey River Bike Trail and then leads to the rolling foothills of Bonsall, CA. Enjoy the towering jagged cliffs along Old Highway 395 as the route takes you to [Deer Park Winery](#), the Century Challenge for the Cure turnaround point.

On your way back to the finish line, enjoy a complimentary lunch with music at the Century lunch stop located approximately at mile 59 at Mance Buchanon Park, located in Oceanside, CA.

Ride back down the coast and along the SR 56 Bike Trail to the finish line at Torrey Pines High School. Celebrate your accomplishments with family and friends at our bar-becue finish line festival with live music, entertainment and more.

All Tour de Cure routes are fully supported with rest stops every 10-15 miles. Each rest stop is equipped with a bike mechanic, snacks, water, sports drinks provided by [A*P*X](#) and first aid. SAG vehicles, HAM operators and Tour de Cure staff monitor and are available to fully assist riders during the event. [UC Cyclery](#) Ride Marshals will also be monitoring the route and are able to assist any participants that may need a simple bike fix or have a question about the route. Ride Marshals will ride with participants with 1 Ride Marshal to every 25-30 participants.

Afraid of getting lost? Don't worry, this year's routes will be clearly marked. Cue sheets will be published prior to the event and will be available at the start line, rest stops and with SAG vehicles and Ride Marshals.
