What to bring to Packet Pick-Up:

Your signed Waiver/Emergency Contact form:

Blank Waiver/Emergency contact form was included in your participation packet which was mailed to you. If you do not have it, you can easily print one out from our main page. Go to <u>www.diabetes.org/shiptoshoretourdecure</u> and you will find it under Resources & Links. Please print and fill out the form taking care not to complete the "<u>For Office Use Only</u>" section.

If you are also picking up for other team members or other individual riders, you **MUST** have a signed waiver for **EACH** rider in order for us to assign a rider bib. All minors (anyone under 18 as of April 29, 2012) must have a waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian.

A minimum of \$175 in donations:

If you have collected online and reached or surpassed \$175 less than 5 days prior to your packet pick-up date, please print and bring a copy of your web-page to ensure you can receive your rider bib. If you still have checks or cash to submit, please bring those items with you and read the next section.

Your Collection envelope:

Please place any checks or cash that you have received inside the envelope, note the amount of each donation on the back and total donations contained in the envelope on the front. If you do not have a collection envelope, please place the items in any envelope and be prepared to fill-out a collection envelope when you arrive.

You must have a rider bib to participate in Tour de Cure on April 29th. You will receive your rider bib at packet pick-up.

Registration at Advance Packet Pick-up

If you have not yet registered for Tour de Cure Ship to Shore and wish to do so at Advance Packet Pick-Up and receive your rider bib, you must provide a minimum of \$200. (\$25 registration fee plus \$175 in funds raised) We accept Master Card, Visa, American Express, check or cash.
